Billy Ray joined Rock Star Missionary Baptist Church at an early age. He graduated from Carter High School in 1968. While at Carter High School, he played basketball and according to him, every time he was at the goal to shoot his Dad would yell 1 -2 which is how he got his nickname. Billy Ray continued his education at Jackson State University and earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree. While at JSU, he became a member of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc. He helped to form and coach the Mississippi State Hospital female softball team. When Billy Ray wasn't playing softball, he was refereeing softball and basketball games. He was an active member of Rock Star Missionary Baptist Church where he served in different capacities: Sunday School Superintendent, Member of the Male Choir, Treasurer and Vacation Bible School Assistant.
