



Mr. Chaleyl Tyriek Alexander

May 2, 1996 - May 9, 2026

Chaleyl Tyriek Alexander (Hebrew Name: Ahsook ben BarachEl and also known as "Toon" to some) was delivered at home in Jackson, MS on 2 May 1996 to Curtis (BarachEl and Florene (Metsadah) Alexander. Chaleyl's father and mother joined the House of Israel Hebrew Culture Center in July 1996 under the leadership of the late Honorable & Enlightened Rabbi Robert Devine. It was at the HOIHCC where Chaleyl was taught the Hebrew way of life and continued to learn with Nahvee Ariel Marshall at the Word of Truth Ministry of MS. He had his Bar Mitzvah at the age of 13 and was baptized thereafter.

On 9 May 2026, one week after his 30th birthday, the life of Chaleyl Alexander came to an abrupt end.
