Deacon Dennis Harvie Owens was born August 9, 1941.

He was the third of four children born to the late James & Marjorie Owens. He accepted Christ at an early age at Rehobeth CME Methodist Church, Letohatchee, Alabama. Dennis (known as Brother O) was a Deacon and devoted member until his death at Rock Hill Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor LaCharles Brister, in Braxton, Mississippi.

Deacon Dennis, graduated from Dunbar High School in Ramer, Alabama, then moved to Minneapolis, Minnesota. 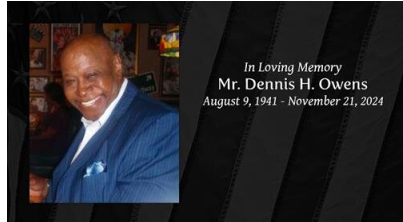
