



Mrs. Doich Bell Anderson

April 14, 1926 - August 9, 2025

Doich Bell Anderson, age 99, made a peaceful transition from this earthly life on August 9, 2025, in the home of her niece, where she had resided for the past six years! Doich was born April 14, 1926, to Arthur and Ida Lynn Newsome Walker, both of whom preceded her in death. She united in holy matrimony as a young teenager to the late Lenna Anderson of Magee, Mississippi. Though this union produced no children, Doich regarded her nephew, Willie Walker, as a son and together with his wife Anna, Willie made certain that Mrs. Anderson had sufficient care and comfort during her later years, especially after she began residing in the home of her niece. They saw to it that Doich was thoroughly supported, and additional assistance provided to her by Terry Walker, wife of her nephew, Sammy J. Walker.

At an early age, Doich united with the Rock Pisgah Baptist Church in Mendenhall, Mississippi. After relocating from Mendenhall to Jackson, Mississippi in the late 1950's with her sister, she continued to attend services at Rock Pisgah Baptist Church regularly on designated pastoral Sundays. Willie ensured that transportation from Jackson to Mendenhall and back for the church services was arranged for Doich and her sister, Her attendance only ceased due to her failing health.

Doich, alongside her sister, was employed at the King Edward Hotel, Jackson, MS, for well over 50 years, until its closure in 1967. Following the closure of

the King Edward, she and her sister made the short trek down the street to the Edison Walthall where she remained employed well into her seventies. Both she and her sister considered themselves the connoisseurs of fruit trays and salads and was, able to prepare ever kind of salad, from memory, known to man.

Born into a very large family, Doich was the fifth of fourteen siblings all of whom preceded her in death. These included Josephine Benson, Dorothy Berry, hrene Craft, rene nubbard, Argie J. Stapleton, Odell Bradford, Aline Overby, Glen Walker, James Walker, Dan Walker, Mims Walker, Maggie Walker, and L.

D. Walker.

To cherish her memories, Doich leaves well over fifty nieces and nephews, a host of other relatives and friends including Pastor Carl L. hunt and wife, Joyce E. hunt of Green Pastures Daptist Church in Jackson, Mississippi, who fondly remembered her consistently with prayers, visits, and tangible acts of kindness or wel over so lears and her oudduas she cared ner nanie Overby Stapleton, a niece, who made daily phone calls to her for more than two decades.
