Earsell Collier, Jr. affectionately known to family, friends and associates as "JR" was born December 7, 1963 in Jackson, Mississippi to Mr. Earsell Sr. and the late Mrs. Carrie Austin Collier.

As a young child, JR accepted Jesus as his personal Savior and embraced the Baptist Faith in Gulfport, Mississippi. He believed in God and lived his life based upon Christian principles.

JR assumed the rank "middle sibling" in his family with much love and laughter. He always demonstrated genuine concern for his sisters, Winnell, Angela and Mary.

JR graduated from Harrison Central High School in 1981. He earned a Bachelors Degree in Business from Jackson State University in 1985. He was a proud member of the "Sonic Boom of the South" Marching Band of Jackson State University.

JR served as an active duty Army First Lieutenant (1990-1991) in Operation Desert Storm. JR was then promoted to Captain and served as an inactive reservist until his sudden demise.

He moved to Dallas, Texas in 1998 and was employed with Georgia-Pacific

for twenty-seven years, as a National Account Manager. He continued to pursue his education and received a Masters of Business Administration from the University of Phoenix in 2009. JR retired in July of 2022.

His interests included fine dining, watching football (Dallas Cowboys and JSU), traveling, shopping, and a lover of car shows. Although our hearts are heavy today, JR is rejoicing because he lived his life in such a manner that on October 14, 2023, he was able to answer the call from his Heavenly Father.

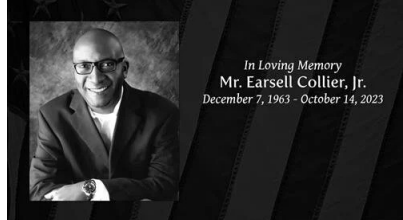
