Elijah Jones was born in Rankin County to Ben Jr. and Naomi (Taylor) Jones on April 4, 1937. He was often referred to as "Larsh" and "Doc".

Elijah attended Pleasant Grove School and graduated from Campbell College High School in 1958. He began work at the old G.R. Worthington dairy farm at an early age. He later retired after 35 years from Trilogy Communications in 2001. He was a loyal, dedicated, and devoted employee.

Elijah married the love of his life, Winnie Ann (Brown) Jones in 1962. They married and made a home together in Brandon, MS for 55 years. They had two children: Bradford "Mahib Jalil" Jones and Roderick Jones.
