



Frederick Louis Weathers

December 29, 1941 - April 30, 2018

Born on December 29, 1941, in Grace, Mississippi, Frederick Louis Weathers was the only son of Rev. Charlie and Ruby Scott Weathers. Fred, or "Bubber", as he was known from an early age, grew up in McGehee, Arkansas and attended Desha Elementary and High Schools. He loved fishing, playing pool, and hanging with his many friends.

Upon graduation from Desha High School, where he excelled on the basketball court, Bubber moved to Greenville, Mississippi where he met and married Yvonne Foster. To this union four children were born. He started a career working with Yvonne's dad in the concrete business, developing and excelling in a skill that he loved. During those early years, he had the opportunity to work on laying the groundwork for the first Sands Casino in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Bubber always enjoyed visits from his sisters, where he could spoil them with as much catfish and as many hot tamales as they desired. To say that he was proud of his children is an understatement. If you knew him, you saw the light in his eyes, the smile on his face, and the expansion of his chest when he spoke about his children. You also knew the sadness he felt when his daughter, Sonya, preceeded him in death. Following an unfortunate accident, Bubber spent most of his years under hospital care. He was away from home, but always wanted to know how his babies were doing. Later in life, he would amaze everyone by speaking in detail of the family history, which he heard as

a child and never forgot.

Fred transitioned from this life on Monday, April 30, 2018 after a lengthy illness. He is survived by his wife, Yvonne; two daughters: Monica and Lisa; one son, Fred, Jr.; ten grandchildren and great grandchildren and four sisters; and a host of nieces, nephews, relatives and friends.
