IVORY JOE DORSEY, the eighth of ten children, was born on February 19, 1946 in Tougaloo, Mississippi to the late Eugene and Hattie B. Dorsey.

IVORY JOE received formal education at Holy Ghost Catholic School, Young Elementary, and G.N. Smith Elementary Schools. He graduated from Sam M. Brinkley Jr. and Sr. High School in 1964. While at Brinkley, he was an honor student and played on the baseball team. After high school, he attended Jackson State University and graduated in 1968 with a degree in Elementary Education. He was employed as a math teacher at Westside Elementary and Junior High School. His aspirations changed. He became a car salesman for Paul Moak Pontiac and later became the used Car Manager.

IVORY JOE was an avid golfer and enjoyed traveling. He loved the Lord and was a member of the Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church of Tougaloo, Mississippi.

In October 1968, Ivory Joe married Jennie B. Johnson. From that union, one son was born. In August 1989, he then married Joyce Sutton.

IVORY JOE went home to be with the Lord on Wednesday, February 28, 2024, in Dallas, Texas.

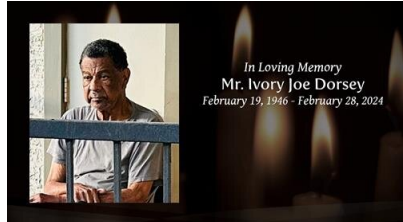
