Jia vonne' (Brown) Scott was born on May 20, 1970, in Racine, Wisconsin to the late Jerry (Moore) Brown and Albert Brown who welcomed her with six siblings to come home to - affectionally known as The Magnificent Seven. She grew up in New Orleans and later moved to Jackson, where she then graduated from Callaway High School. She received her Bachelor of Accountancy from THEE Jackson State University followed by acquiring her CPA. She later obtained her Master of Accountancy from Millsaps College while growing her family and serving her community.

She met her husband, David Tyron Scott, in the fall of 1991, they went on to marry April 3, 1993. Jia was a devoted wife and a beloved mother. Together, they shared 33 years of love and raised three children — one daughter, one son, and a niece.

Professionally, she worked as a CPA throughout her career; quickly advancing to be one of the Vice Presidents of Cal-Maine Foods. She was known at work for her dedication, kindness, and work ethic. Community service was her motto where she devoted so many years to serving others. Most notably she served The Junior League of Jackson and a host of other organizations like Friends of Children's and Canopy Children's Solutions.

Outside of work, Jia enjoyed strutting in her 4-inch heels being the biggest

little boss that filled the room with her personality and order. Whether you met her for a brief moment or knew her for a lifetime, you felt her presence the moment she walked in. On her own terms, she confidently lived life to the fullest; often making the impossible possible. One of her greatest accomplishments was gaining her GiGi title where she thrived in spending time and spoiling her three grandchildren - JR, Daylin, and her namesake Vonne.

On Wednesday, April 8, 2026, the Lord called her home, at the age of 55. She is survived by her husband, Tyron; her son, Evan; her daughter Meagan (DeAndre'); her niece/bonus child Kerin (Mareio); her father, Al; her sibling(s), Chanel (Tevis), Dante' (Danielle), April, Delanio, Shawn (Renea), & Avila; and a plethora of nieces and nephews.
