John was drafted at the age of 20 into the United States Army during the Korean War. Sergeant John served as Medium Tank Commander in the 160th Infantry, 40th Infantry Division from October 1952 to January 1953 at Heartbreak Ridge in Korea.

He first found love and married Lula Mae Gipson on July 3, 1954. From this union, 10 children were born.

John M. Brown attended the former Campbell College which later became a part of what we now know as Jackson State University. He earned his brick masonry certification. He provided for his family through this trade and other talents he developed.

He was an entrepreneur at heart. Dad owned a pucker wood truck, hauling trees which he and his sons both cut and transported. John was also a seasoned

farmer. He grew many crops over his farming years through the work of his hands along with his family. God surely blessed and multiplied it year after year. After retiring multiple times, he continued building beautiful things. Rather than bricking homes, hearths, and chimneys, etc., he added roofing to beautifully hand-crafted, extravagant birdhouses at Hartwood Co. in Star, Mississippi.

His love for ministry expanded from the beautiful island of Haiti to the local prisons. John was a faithful member of Word of Life church where he served as a greeter. His fatherly disposition caused him to gain many children over the years. As time passed, John suffered a great loss in the passing of his wife of 54 years.

Fortunately, John found love again and married Delia Smith on January 15, 2012. They were happily married for 10 years.
