Mr. L.C. Weakley was born May 27, 1947 to the late Roddie Lee Sr. and James Etta Weakley. He was preceded in death by his parents, one sister, Ella Jean Collier and one brother, Charles Weakley.

At an early age, he dedicated his life to Christ through baptism and began his Christian journey at Evergreen United Methodist Church, and later joined Pilgrim Rest, Missionary Baptist Church of Morton, Mississippi. He later returned to his home church Evergreen United Methodist Church where he remained faithful as a Sunday school superintendent and usher until his health declined. He was a devoted husband, father, mentor, and leader to his family, friends and community.

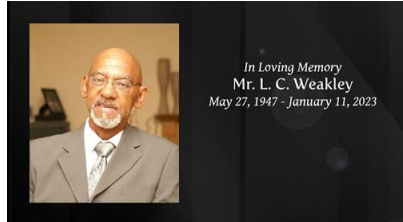

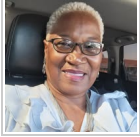
