LeFredrick Demond Taylor was born in Jackson, Mississippi on May 12, 1977, to Eddie Charles Taylor and Janice McKee.

He showed his children how to go to God in prayer and give Him praise for all things.

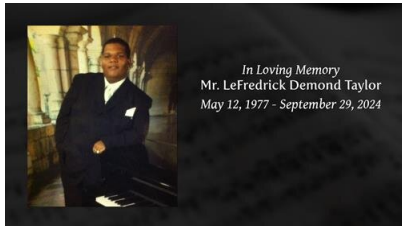
