Leviticus Wilson was born April 30, 1923 to Hattie Square and Samuel Kimbrough Sr., in Meridian, Mississippi. All of her siblings preceded her in death. Four Brothers: Samuel Kimbrough; Jimmie Jones; Charlie Jones; Hilton Jones; Two Sisters: Christine Taylor and Ernestine Johnson.

Her friends and coworkers all called her Lee, but she was best known as Lou by her family.

At the age of 16 she moved from Brandon, MS to St. Louis, Missouri and graduated from Sumner High School. She joined Galilee Baptist Church on March 19, 1961 where she was a member of the Usher's Ministry.

Lee worked in private family for many years, she also worked for St. Louis Children's Hospital, and UMSL. In 1964 Leviticus went to work at Washington University in St. Louis, and there she became the first Black House Keeping Supervisor.

Once Leviticus retired in 1988, she volunteered at Cardinal Ritter Institute for The Foster Grandparents program for over 25 years. All of the Kids called her Grandma.

Leviticus departed this life on Saturday Morning April 27, 2019 at Delmar Gardens Nursing Home North.
