Mrs. Lois Redd Sutton was the 4th child born to the late Mr. Vernon "V.D." Redd and Mrs. Lucy Fultz Redd on October 31, 1943. She was preceded in death by her beloved son, Ellis Anthony Sutton, and three sisters: Eva Russell, Inez Washington, and Grace Logan.

Lois confessed Christ at an early age and became a member of Taylorsville United Methodist Church, now known as Trinity United Methodist Church. She was an active member and served on the Food Pantry Ministry, Angel Tree committee, and various other roles until her health began to fail.

On November 10, 1959, Lois united in holy matrimony to Robert E. Sutton, Sr., whom she affectionately called Edward. To this union, three children, eleven grandchildren, and nineteen great-grandchildren were born.

Lois attended cosmetology school in Chicago, IL where she began her lifelong profession as a hair stylist. She worked tirelessly in her salon, where she developed life-long relationships and friendships that she treasured. Being a wife, mother, and grandmother was truly her most valued accomplishment.
