In addition to her many accomplishments, she was called to open up her own salon where she touched many lives.

In her spare time, Lorean enjoyed singing, spreading the word, fishing, cooking, reading the Bible, family time, and began in the presence of the Lord, Until Monday afternoon May 11th The Lord saw His child suffering and called her home. Lorean is preceded in death by her two children Trameka Bilbro & Billy Lee, one Brother Frank Lyles; grandparents Edd & Arrie B. Bilbro, Alonzo Lyles, Pearl P. Bilbro; one Great Granddaughter, Cherish Bilbro.
