Marilyn Womack was born September 19, 1936 in Florence, Mississippi to the late Luvell Gayden and Mouninda Young Gayden. Her family attended the Good Hope Missionary Baptist Church where Marilyn Womack accepted Jesus Christ as her personal Savior and was baptized. Upon completing school, she moved to New Orleans, Louisiana where she married the late Mr. Edgar Womack, and to this union seven (7) children were born.

In New Orleans, Marilyn Womack was united with the Greater St. John Baptist Church where she served faithfully in several ministries. On June 3, 1997, she received her Doctor of Letters with all the honors, rights, and privileges to that diploma from the Christian Bible College of Louisiana. Marilyn Womack loved sharing the Word of God with anyone who would listen. She was a student of God's Word.

After Hurricane Katrina in 2005, she decided to relocate to Florence, Mississippi, and she reunited with the Good Hope Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Moses Johnson and later under the leadership of Pastor Kevin C. Thomas. At Good Hope, Marilyn Womack served as a Sunday School teacher for Adult Women, Bible Class teacher, and Vacation Bible School teacher.
