



Rev. Marvin Kenneth Horton

Marvin Kenneth Horton was born on September 10, 1953, to the late Emmitt and Ada Bell Williams in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He departed this earthly life on Friday, November 8, 2024.

Marvin joined Canaan Baptist Church at an early age, where he became a member of the choir and the usher board. He later transferred his membership to Cathedral of Praise Church, where he met the love of his life.

On August 8, 2004, he united in holy matrimony with Margaret Clayton Horton, and they were married for 20 wonderful years. Marvin enlisted in the U.S. Army Reserves and was honorably discharged. He worked in the food industry as a cook and manager. In his leisure time, he enjoyed watching sports and westerns, as well as spending time with family and friends.

Later in life, Marvin answered the call to ministry under the leadership of Pastor Simpson in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He subsequently moved to Mississippi, where he joined Damascus Missionary Church under Pastor Oscar Dear Sr. Marvin, and his wife were ordained by Pastor Verneal Lipsey Sr. After Pastor Dear's passing, Marvin was appointed as the Pastor of Damascus Missionary Baptist Church, a position he held for seven years. In 2021, he later became a member of Walnut Hill Missionary Baptist Church.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 20 years, Evangelist Margaret Horton; two daughters, Veronica (Greg) Lott and Tamela (Willie) Orelus; and one son, Jamie (Latisha) Riley. He is also survived by three siblings: Albert Williams, Brenda Williams, and Raymond (Lisa) Williams, all of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He leaves behind six grandchildren: Tataynna, Dylan, Jaylen, Jamarion, Symone, and Quincy, along with two great-grandchildren, Chance and Khale. Additionally, there is a special individual, Majour, who held a significant place in his heart, as well as a host of nieces and nephews. Marvin was preceded in death by his father, Emmitt Williams, and his mother, Ada Bell Williams.
