Born Maurice McLin on July 20, 1968, in Jackson, Mississippi, Maurice was the fifth of six (6) children. His parents, the late Lloyd C. McLin, Sr. and Lucille Smith McLin, preceded him in death. Also, his brothers Michael and Lloyd McLin, Jr. along with nephew Calvin McLin preceded him in death.

permit him to continue in this profession. This prompted him to rely on the talents that God had given him. He was notorious for collecting all types of items and restoring them, carving wood and sculpting them into beautiful eyesores. On December 16, 2018 at approximately 11:30 p.m., Maurice expired from this earthly life at his home in Brandon, Mississippi after an asthmatic attack.
