Oliver was a long-time resident of Pearl MS starting July 1966. He was lovingly known to his family as a "professional talker". Oliver worked as a night

watchman at Standard Oil Company, Jackson MS for many years. His dream job from his youth was to be a truck driver. His love of driving trucks stemmed from working for a cattle buyer in his youth. He would sit on a pillow and drive trucks for Mr. Pete White who he often talked about. Oliver drove for Mississippi Materials Company (now MMC) for twenty-seven years, where he won top driver at their truck rodeo one year and that gave him bragging rights and oh did, he brag. After he retired, he drove school buses for Pearl Public Schools. Oliver was a father that provided for his "four crumb snatchers" as he referred to his children.

Oliver accepted Christ into his life at an early age at New Hope M.B. Church, Gloster MS. Upon moving to Pearl, he, along with his family, joined Mt Holum M.B. Church, Pearl MS under the leadership of Pastor L. R. Travis. He assumed many duties at Mt Holum throughout the years including Sunday School Superintendent, Sunday School Teacher, Janitor, Choir member, and Male Chorus member. Oliver's most treasured position was being a Deacon of the church which gave him yet another opportunity not just to talk but to tell others about the God he served.

Oliver has always tried to be a mentor to young men in the neighborhood. He was a lover of football and often talked about how his grandmother Alice would not let him play. So, he lived vicariously through his sons and other young men in the neighborhood. He would load the station wagon or the truck and take them to pee-wee football practice and games. He loved to share a pack or two of pecan twirls with everyone afterwards.

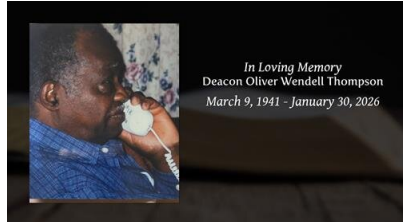
