Six months later, he was adopted to a loving couple, Mr. Johnnie and Lola Mae Fairley of Prentiss, MS. He departed this life Sunday, February 10, 2019 at 304 Newsome Road in Mendenhall, MS. He acknowledged Christ as his Savior at a very early age and was baptized at Mt. Carmel Church in Prentiss, MS. He obtained his education at Prentiss High School. He attended Prentiss Institute for 1 year. As a young man, he worked at Ingells Ship Yard, Universal Manufacturing Plant, Halliburton-Offshore, Rival and GNB. On March 12, 1976, he married Mae Bell Newsome-Fairley, to this union God blessed them with two children, one daughter and one son. He enjoyed riding bikes with Boys on 2 Wheels, a group out of Simpson County. He loved old classic cars and trucks. He was a Ford man and he enjoyed football and telling bible stories. Reverend Fairley answered the call to preach in August of 1997. He did his first sermon on November 2, 1997 after which he was ordained. He was youth pastor at Rose Hill Church in Mendenhall, MS for 14 years. He pastored Pearlie Grove for over a year, played drums for the Rose Hill Male Choir and inspirational choir, taught and reviewed Sunday School. He remained faithful in serving on God's program until his health began to fail. Even then, he had the sermon sent into his home via cell phone. Reverend Fairley loved his family, church family and his community. He was preceded in death by one brother, Ronnie Earl Magee and three sisters, Arletha "Lottie" Woodson, Mary Lois Armstrong and Joyce

Armstrong.
