Mr. Robert Lee Wright Jr. was born on October 31, 1940, in Pickens, MS to the late Robert Wright who was a farmer and Albrintha Ross-Wright who was a homemaker. He departed his life on January 24, 2024, peacefully in his home. He was the third of four children: Ethel Bea Tillman, John Lee Wright and Caldonia Wright, who preceded him in death.

He grew up in Goodman, MS and joined the Georgeville United Methodist Church in Goodman at an early age. Robert attended Georgeville Public Schools and Richland Vocational High School. He graduated in the Class of 1959.

He married Pearlie Mae Levy and they moved to Jackson, MS, where they raised five children: Tony, Robert, Clara, Sandra and Debara.

He started his working career installing insulation, roofing, and construction work. He then took a delivery job at a well-known flower shop called Pridgen's Florist. Because his parents always grew beautiful plants, he enjoyed his work. He was a longtime florist and went on to be the owner/operator of Florist Inc. until he suffered a stroke in 1991.

Robert was widely known for his ability to shoot pool and travelled around the state participating in various pool tournaments. In fact, he specialized in

repairing music and entertainment equipment. He could fix just about anything. He was the type of man that never met a stranger. if you knew him, you knew a friend.

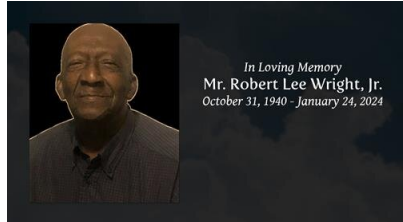
