After graduating from Morton High School, she continued her pursuit of knowledge at Hinds Community College,

and later, the University of Mississippi Medical Center, where she obtained her nurse practitioner degree. Her professional path led her through meaningful positions at Whitfield State Hospital, the University of Mississippi Medical Center, Simpson General Clinic, and Raymond Detention Center before she made the groundbreaking decision to open her own clinic, Alpha and Omega Health Services, in Mendenhall, Mississippi. Among her career journey, Sandra found accomplishment in publishing her autobiography, "Temporary Power Outages", a feat that she was incredibly proud of.

At an early age, Sandra professed her love for Christ. She was a member of Lone Pine Church in Lena, Mississippi, and later became a devoted member of Rose Hill M.B. Church in Mendenhall, Mississippi, where she served as a faithful member.
