She was always attending functions with her kids to ensure they experienced all that life had to offer and never missed a school function. Shante" also spent a lot of time with "The Sisters', the term she used to fondly speak of her mother's sisters. She was always available to provide a listening ear and was the chaperone for many a concert and state fairy for her younger siblings and cousins. 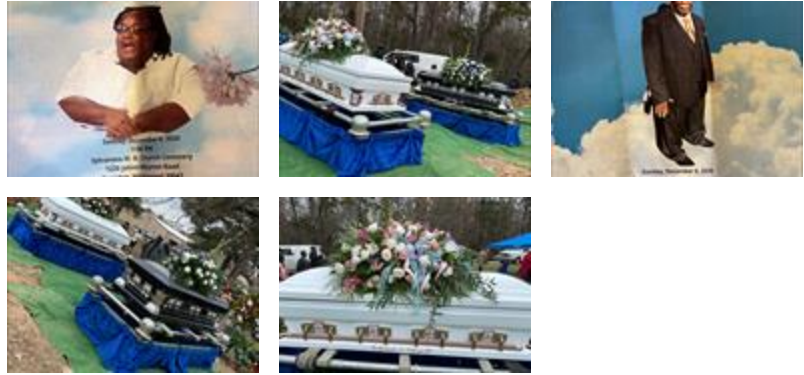
